STEP 5

All animals entered in the show must be ARI registered, have a negative BVDV PCR or VI test, be microchipped and have a Certificate of Veterinarian Inspection (health papers) completed by your veterinarian within 30 days of the last day of the show. We will need the original and one photocopy of the health papers, also please bring a copy of your ARI certificate. The health certificate must include for each alpaca, the alpaca's ARI name, the microchip number and the negative results of the BVDV PCR or VI test. A veterinarian-supervised representative from the show will verify and examine the health certificate, the PCR or VI test result and the microchip for each alpaca in the show. This step is very important to ensure a smooth check in process. **Animals that do not meet these criteria will not be allowed to enter the building.**

**All cancellations must be made in writing and sent to Nora Custer-Haberbusch, Custer's Alpacas, 744 Clyde Street, Akron, OH 44310
Cancellations made prior to November 1, 2009 will be charged \$50.00 plus \$15.00 per animal. No refunds for cancellations made after November 1, 2009 or for no-shows.**

GENERAL AND STALLING INFORMATION

- ◆ This is an AOBA certified show. All Halter Classes will be evaluated using a comparative method using a 50/50 basis respectively for fleece and conformation. All rules or amended rules of the 2009 AOBA Show Division Handbook will be followed. We encourage you to join the AOBA Show Division and become familiar with the handbook.
- ◆ Animal substitutions will be allowed from the original Halter Class Entry Form if permission is obtained from the show superintendent, Peg Stephens at pegstephens@earthlink.net or 812/294-4880. Permission must be obtained **prior** to arriving at the show. There will be a \$25 animal substitution fee.
- ◆ Ohio Expo Center will not have an emergency phone number available the weekend of our event. If you do have an emergency, you may call Nora Custer-Haberbusch's cell phone at 216/235-0367. We ask that you restrict the use of this number to emergencies.
- ◆ Please note that no animals or exhibits will be permitted on-site prior to the Friday, November 6, 10 a.m. check-in. All exhibits and animals must be removed from the Ohio Expo premises by 10 p.m. on Sunday, November 8. **THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- ◆ Camping (located off 17th Avenue) is available for \$22 a night. First come, first served. No reservations. Tent camping is not available. There are no water hookups and the restrooms will be closed. There is electric and sewer. See map on back cover for location. It is quite a walk to the Bricker Building.
- ◆ The AlpacaFest Show can always use volunteers regardless of level of commitment. Volunteering is a great way to learn and network with others. If you would like to help with the halter show, please contact Nora Custer-Haberbusch at nora@custersalpaca.com or 216/235-0367. If you would like to volunteer for the fleece show, please contact Jana Lee-Harris at jleeharris@aol.com or at 740/964-1574.
- ◆ There will be 10' × 12' vendor spaces available for \$275, includes electricity. For further information, contact Joe Osborn at joe4browns@aol.com or at 740/225-1337 or download the forms from OABA's Web site, <http://www.ohioalpacaassociation.com>.
- ◆ The stalls will be 7' × 14' and will have cardboard bedding. Exhibitors will need to provide their own stall mats. No more than three (3) yearling and older or four (4) juvenile alpacas will be allowed per stall. There will be no division of stalls. If you are sharing a stall with another farm, please indicate on the Registration Form. You must be entered in the show to rent a stall. All alpacas must be registered for a class. Due to space limitations, we cannot allow companion animals. If you are sharing a stall, have one farm reserve all the stalls including your farm display stall. If you reserve your stalls separately there are no guarantees you will be stalled together. Do not request being stalled next to another farm if you are reserving your stalls separately.
- ◆ Farm displays are welcome and encouraged. Farm displays may be reserved as 7' × 14' stalls. Only one (1) display stall will be allowed per farm. Fire safety and facility rules do not allow farm displays to extend into the aisles. Farm displays are intended to promote your farm, not retail sales. No more than 10% of your booth may be devoted to retail sales. If you need more space, please rent a vendor stall.
- ◆ Stall space is limited and assignments are made on a first-come, first-served basis, by postmark, and in accordance with the layout available to best fit the space and layout design. Grand, Platinum and Gold sponsors will receive preferred stalling.
- ◆ Feed and hay must be provided by exhibitor.
- ◆ Electricity and water are available at strategic points throughout the stall area. Please bring your own electric cords for fans, etc. Fans are permitted in the stalls but not in the aisle-way. A tack aisle will be located directly behind your stalls for storage of all your belongings. This aisle is closed to the public. It is the responsibility of each farm to keep their area clean at all times.
- ◆ A card will be provided for each exhibitor for security and emergency purposes. Please fill out the emergency and hotel information and affix card to your stalls.
- ◆ All attendees will be assessed a \$5 parking fee generally collected for admission to the Ohio Expo Center. Event parking passes (3-day) are still available for the same rate of \$12 at the Ohio Expo Center's admission gate. You may purchase this pass upon arrival at the Expo entrance gate on Friday, November 6.
- ◆ All animals must be vet checked on Friday and stalled for the remainder of the show. The Ohio Expo Center prohibits dogs in the buildings. No roller blades, roller skates, or skateboards, etc. are allowed in the Ohio Expo Center.
- ◆ Parents are responsible for their children. Children must be kept under supervision at all times.

SHOW AND ENTRY INFORMATION

- ◆ Halter show judges are: Jude Anderson, Huacaya and Suri males; Amanda VandenBosch, Huacaya and Suri females and all of the performance class.
- ◆ An exhibitors meeting will be held at 7:30 p.m., Friday, November 6 in the show ring for the purpose of updating you on information for the show. **Attendance is mandatory.**
- ◆ We will have two (2) rings going simultaneously. One for males, one for females. A third ring will be for Performance classes. Please make sure you have enough handlers for each class.
- ◆ The handler's attire for the Halter and Showmanship classes should be conservative, neat, and appropriate for the class. No open toe shoes. The obstacle classes are very casual classes. Please dress comfortably with freedom of movement so as to easily maneuver the obstacles.
- ◆ All alpacas entered must be registered with the Alpaca Registry, Inc. and microchipped.
- ◆ All alpacas must be entered in the name of the owner as listed on the ARI Registration Certificate. Animals that are being purchased or certificates that have not been transferred must have a "Owner of Record" form signed by the owner that is listed on the ARI Registration Certificate. The form can be downloaded from the show division Web site: www.alpacashows.com. An animal may NOT be entered in any halter class more than once. Handlers other than owners do not need a owner of record form as long as the animal is entered and registered with AlpacaFest under the owner's name. AOBA show rules do not allow animals with pending papers to show.
- ◆ Age of alpaca is determined from the date of the first scheduled day of judging – November 7, 2009.
- ◆ Because exhibitors may not know who the other exhibitors are until arrival, entry deadlines for the Get of Sire and Produce of Dam classes is 6 p.m. on Saturday, November 7. If the exhibitor is not the owner of the Sire or Dam, written permission from the owner shown on the ARI Registration Certificate must be submitted. ARI Registration Certificate for Dam or Sire must be submitted if not entered in the show. A copy of the ARI Registration Certificate for each of the three progeny in Get of Sire and two progeny in Produce of Dam must also be provided to the Show Superintendent, if entering at the show. All offspring must be eligible and entered in their respective halter classes. Be aware that any additions will not be listed in the show book. Animals must be in full fleece.
- ◆ The Exhibitor Rule applies. The owner can enter only (3) three alpacas per breed type (Huacaya or Suri), per gender, per age division, per color designation.
- ◆ **As an exhibitor, it is your responsibility to be on time for classes.** Once the class has entered the ring and the judge and gatesman have agreed that this is the class, late exhibitors may not enter a class.
- ◆ The entry fees are:

\$40 per class per animal	\$30 for Bred and Owned Yearling
\$30 for Get of Sire (3 animals)	\$30 for Breeders Best of Three
\$30 for Produce of Dam (2 animals)	\$15 for youth entered in classes designated as "Youth"
\$30 for Open Gelding (18+ months)	<i>This is one fee per youth exhibitor for youth classes only.</i>
\$30 for Non-Breeding Female (18+ months)	\$20 Open (Non-Youth) Performance and Exhibition classes
- ◆ Prizes will include rosette ribbon for 1st through 6th place in each class, with banners for Color and Reserve Champions.
- ◆ All entries postmarked after Monday, October 5, 2009 will be charged a late fee of \$30 for each animal entered in addition to the normal entry fee.
- ◆ Incomplete and/or incorrect entries may be assessed an additional \$25 processing and handling fee. Please ensure that your entries are correct. You are welcome to contact any of the people listed in this registration book for answers to your questions.
- ◆ AOBA requires us to assess a \$75 showing fee for all farms that are not members of the AOBA Show Division. This fee is per farm, not per animal.
- ◆ Any question about color and fiber length will be resolved at the time of check-in. **Please check your animal's color with the ARI color chart and the 2009 AOBA Show Division Handbook color definitions before filling out the class entry form.** Please review the 2009 AOBA Show Division Handbook for color definitions. The Handbook color definitions will take precedence.

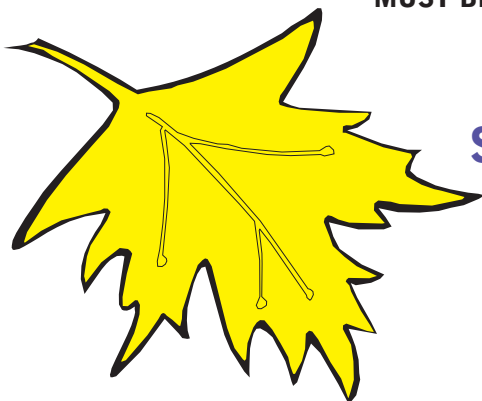

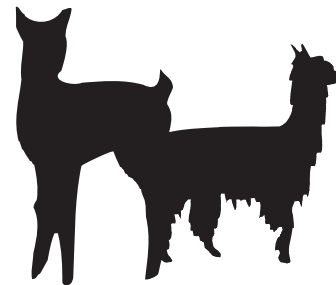

GENERAL HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

1. **All** in-state and out-of-state alpacas must have a Certificate of Veterinarian Inspection (health paper) completed not more than 30 days prior to the last day of the show for each alpaca transported to the show. The certificate to be completed by your veterinarian. Ohio does not require other testing. All alpacas entered in the show must be microchipped. The alpaca's ARI name and microchip number must be included on the Certificate of Veterinarian Inspection (health paper) for each alpaca entered in the show and will be checked upon entering the facility.
2. Additional health tests required by AOBA for entrance into our show: a negative (BVDV) bovine viral diarrhea virus PCR or VI test. The negative test result must be noted by your veterinarian on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection. Questions on the PCR test are to be directed to Dr. Larry Agle at 330/569-7855.
3. All Exhibitors are required to provide the Show Superintendent with a photo copy of the original Certificate of Veterinary Inspection that shall be retained in the permanent show records.
4. A representative from OABA will verify and examine health papers.
5. Evidence of infectious or communicable disease, failure to produce the necessary documents for health certification and BVDV testing, or lack of microchip will result in your alpaca being denied entry to the show.

SHOW TIPS

- ◆ Practice with your alpaca. Familiarize having the fleece examined at the shoulder, middle side, and rump. Be prepared to show your alpaca's teeth to the judge.
- ◆ Walk your alpaca around before the class to help the animal relax and loosen up. Before the show begins, walk in the ring to get the alpaca used to the surface.
- ◆ Be sure that your alpaca's halter fits properly. If you are unsure, ask for help. An alpaca supply vendor will be at the show if you need a halter.
- ◆ Do not be afraid to ask for help or advice from your fellow exhibitors; alpaca people are a friendly, helpful bunch.
- ◆ Watch the judge. Smile and have fun!

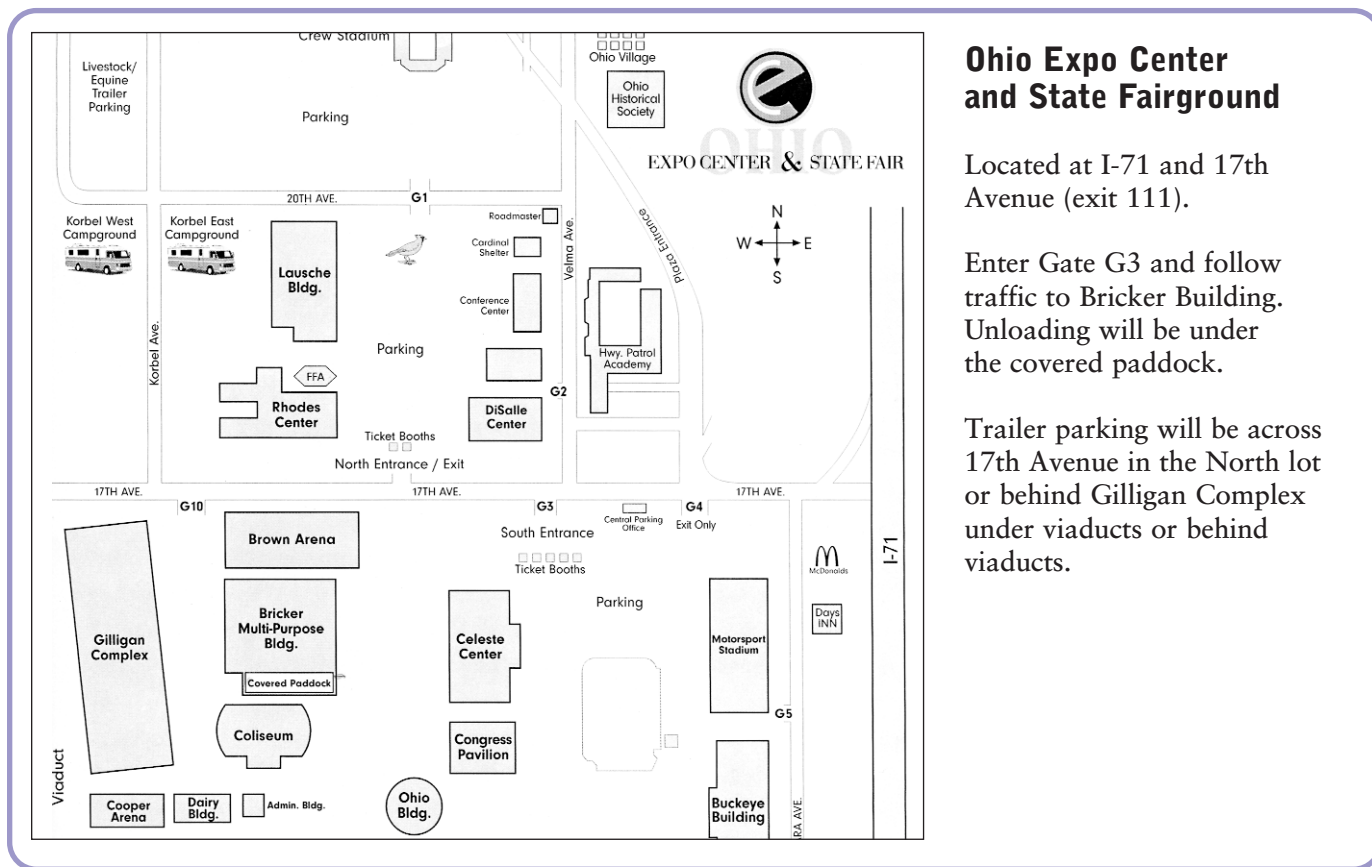
