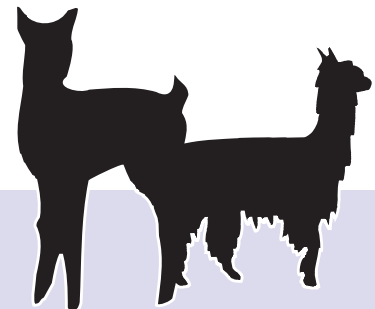

## SHOW AND ENTRY INFORMATION

- ◆ Fleece Judges are: Kathy Klay (all suris, huacaya multis and grays); Diana Timmerman (huacaya whites, lights and fawns); Charlene Friedman (huacaya browns and blacks). The fiber arts judge is Cheryl Laufer. The skein competition judge is Jennifer Folkman. The spin-off judges are Billie Bookamer, Judy Keske, Unni Heineking and Cathy Moore.
- ◆ All alpacas must be entered in the name of the owner as listed on the ARI Registration Certificate. Animals that are being purchased or certificates that have not been transferred must have a “Owner of Record” Form (page 8) signed by the owner that is listed on the ARI Registration Certificate. AOBA show rules do not allow fleece of animals with pending papers to show.
- ◆ Entry fees per item for:
  - \$10 – Fiber Arts
  - \$37 – Fleece Competition (\$32 – Early Bird Entry Fee before September 5, 2009)
  - \$26 – Spin-Off Competition
  - \$16 – Skein Competition
  - \$26 – Mill-Spun Skein Competition
- ◆ Prizes will include rosette ribbon for 1st thru 6th place in each class with special awards.
- ◆ All entries postmarked after the show deadlines will be charged a late fee of \$25 for each entry in addition to the normal entry fee.
- ◆ Incomplete and/or incorrect entries may be assessed an additional \$25 processing and handling fee. Please ensure that your entries are correct. You are welcome to contact any of the people listed in this registration book for answers to your questions.
- ◆ AOBA requires us to assess a \$75 showing fee for all farms that are not members of the AOBA Show Division. This fee is per farm, per event, and not per entry. This applies to halter, performance, fleece, and spin-off competitions.
- ◆ There is a \$6 AOBA recording fee for each fleece and spin-off entry and a \$3 fee for each skein and fiber arts entry. This fee is already included in the above-listed fees.
- ◆ Any question about color and fiber length will be resolved at the time of check-in. **Please check your animal's color with the ARI color chart before filling out the class entry form.** Please review the 2009 AOBA Show Division Handbook for color definitions.

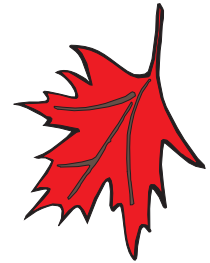

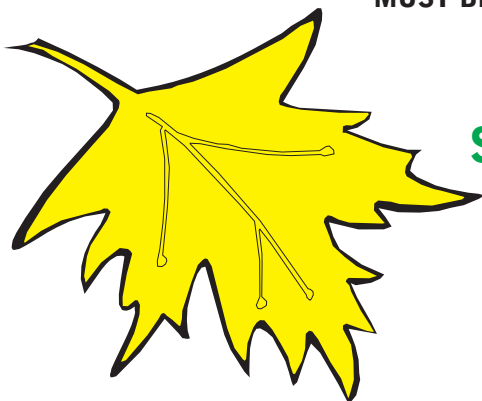

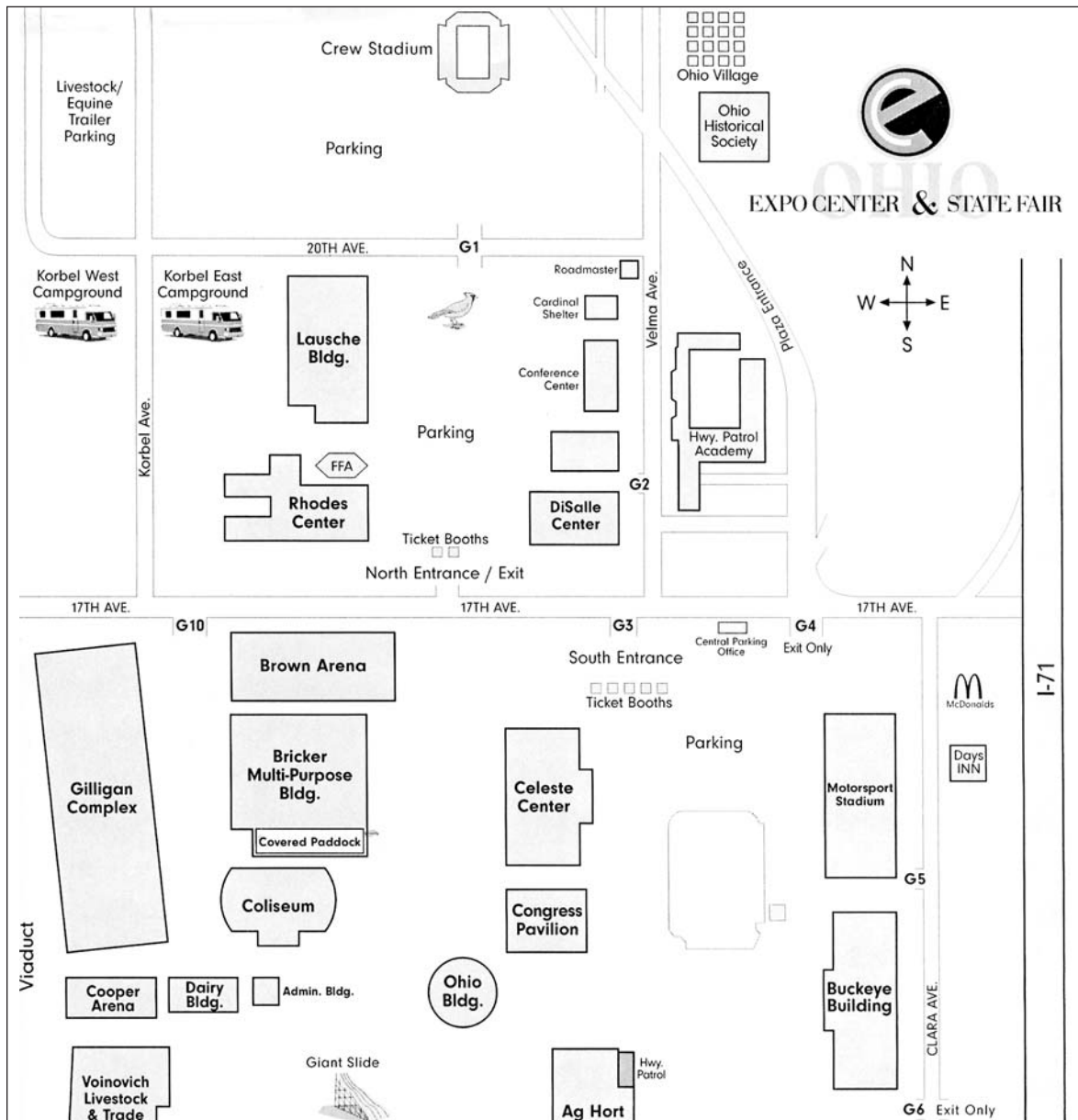

# 2009 MANDATORY EXHIBITOR DISCLOSURE

Under the Show Division Handbook Rules, certain alpacas and fleeces are automatically disqualified from competition and certain Exhibitors & Handlers are prohibited from personally showing in front of a Judge when a business or financial relationship exists between an AOBA Certified Judge and their customers.

Each year at contract renewal time, our Judges are required to disclose those alpacas, exhibitors and handlers who cannot be shown in their show ring when judging at an AOBA Certified show. Exhibitors are also required to disclose business and financial relationships with Judges and to acknowledge animals/fleece entered into the competitions that are not allowed to show in front of certain Judges at each show they attend. This is being done to ensure Exhibitors understand the written rules and to eliminate confusion for Exhibitors & Handlers about which alpacas, Exhibitors & Handlers cannot walk into a Judge's show ring during competition and which fleeces can not be entered into a Fleece Show.

Using your 2009 – Major Changes Document, and when you receive it your 2009 AOBA Show Division Handbook, please see Part 5. Rules & Ethics for All Show Participants; Section 2, Rules for Exhibitors and Handlers,

- S. An alpaca/fleece is disqualified from competition if....,

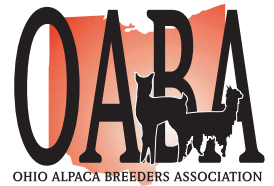

**ALL ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY AUGUST 3, 2009**

**PLEASE SEND FLEECE SAMPLES AS SOON AS POSSIBLE TO FACILITATE SPINNING. THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES AND INSTRUCTIONS WILL APPLY – SOME CHANGES HAVE OCCURRED – READ CAREFULLY!**

- ◆ **Final Deadline:** All entries must be postmarked by August 3, 2009.
- ◆ **Fiber Entry:** Minimum 2 ounces alpaca prime blanket fiber shorn between July 31, 2008 and August 13, 2009.
- ◆ **Entry Fee:** \$26 (includes \$6.00 AOBA recording fee) per 2 ounce sample entered. Add \$75.00 non-member fee if not an AOBA Show Division Member.
- ◆ **Competition Limits:** Only 3 samples per farm/owner/partnership, per breed type, per age division at time of shearing, per color designation.
- ◆ **Awards:** Ribbons for 1st through 6th place.
- ◆ **Entries Displayed:** results of judges' spinning and placing of entries will be on display at the OABA AlpacaFest.

**CLASS DIVISIONS:** Classes to be divided into color groups: white, beige, fawn, brown, black, grey, indefinite dark, indefinite light and multi, if possible. Class may be divided further into specific color designations (i.e. Light Fawn) with appropriate number of entries. Colors with less than four entries may be combined and judged by Light, Dark and Mixed, or by the age division. Final determination of class divisions and entry colors will be made by the spin-off show superintendent.

**ENTRY LIMITATION:** Entries are limited to 3 samples per farm/owner/partnership, per breed type, per age division at time of shearing, per color designation. Example: You can enter a maximum of 3 Light Fawn Huacaya entries in age class number SH-B per farm/owner/partnership.

**Entry Includes:** 1) Entry form; 2) minimum 2 ounces of prime blanket fiber (see more information below about fiber submitted); 3) completed Spin-Off Entry Tag; 4) copy of ARI Registration Certificate and Owner of Record Form (if applicable); and 5) a color photograph no larger than 4" x 6" of alpaca producing the fiber entered. No larger photographs accepted. Entries must be entered by current owner, farm or member of partnership as shown on ARI Registration Certificate or Owner of Record Form and must accompany exhibitor's entry signed by current owner of record of the alpaca as shown on ARI Registration Certificate. Please do not fold certificate or photograph because these will be on display with the judged fleece sample. Please affix photo to copy of ARI Registration for display.

**FIBER SHEARING DATES:** Fleece must have been shorn between July 31, 2008 and August 13, 2009.

**SUBMITTED FIBER:** 2 ounces of prime blanket fiber must be submitted in a clear, unmarked, gallon-size ziplock bag with the completed "OABA Handcrafters' Spin-Off Entry Tag" placed inside the bag with the fiber. NOTE: You need only send 2 ounces of fiber, there is no advantage to sending more than 2 ounces. Please do NOT write on the zip-lock bag. Fiber shall not be carded, combed, washed or otherwise enhanced; however, it should be handpicked of debris and vegetable matter. Fiber with vegetable matter, contamination or

second cuts may be marked down accordingly.

**ANONYMITY:** Fiber will be judged by entry number only, with no exhibitor information visible or available to the judge(s).

**STAPLE LENGTH:** Fiber must be at least 3" long. Fiber samples of less than the 3" minimum or longer than show rules allow and those showing parasitic infestation shall be disqualified. The reason for disqualification shall be recorded on the score card and the Judge's Worksheet.

**HUACAYA –** No maximum length under 1st Birthday, with a maximum of 8" for 1st Birthday and older.

**SURI –** For suris prior to their second birthday, fleece must be a minimum of 3", with no maximum length. There is a maximum length of 9" for suris two years or older.

**JUDGING CRITERIA:** Scoring will be based on first impression, staple length, cleanliness, lack of second cuts, lack of guard hair or medullated fiber, lock structure, luster (suris) or crimp, brightness (huacayas), ease of spinning, ease of preparation, softness of yarn, loft and texture.

**DISQUALIFICATION:** Fiber that is unsound, felted, contains tender breaks, mats, excessive debris will be discounted accordingly but will NOT be disqualified. Points may be deducted for failure to submit at least 2 ounces of fiber for proper sampling and judging. However, fiber submitted and fiber samples exhibiting parasitic infestation or fiber not meeting the 3" minimum or exceeding the maximum lengths are to be disqualified. The reason for disqualification shall be recorded on the score card and the Judge's Worksheet.

**ENTRY RETURNS:** You must include a one time \$7.00 shipping fee to have your entries and awards returned to you following the OABA AlpacaFest. You, or a representative that you designate, may also pick up the fleece entries between noon and 2 p.m. on Sunday, November 8, 2009. Entries not picked up or without adequate prepaid postage WILL NOT BE RETURNED.

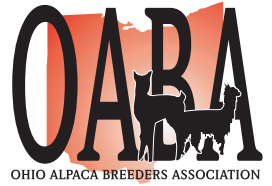

# AlpacaFest 2009

## Fiber Arts and Skein Competitions Guidelines



The AlpacaFest 2009 Fiber Arts and Skein Show and Competition will be a showcase for alpaca fiber. This is the opportunity to display your creative talents and promote the wonderful versatility of alpaca.

### RULES: Fiber Arts

1. Entries must be submitted in the name of the artisan
  - ◆ A completed entry tag must accompany each item
2. Items must have been completed during the last year.
3. All entries, in all classes must consist of a minimum of 50% alpaca fiber.
4. Fiber arts items will be divided by division (beginner, intermediate, and advanced) categories (all handwork – 100% handspun yarns with 100% handmade construction, and or 100% hand felted, partial or non-handwork – use of commercially spun yarn and/or knitting machine construction and less than 100% hand felting), groups (woven, felt, knit, crochet, lace) classes (accessories, shawls, hats, garments, hearth & home)
5. Each artisan may enter 1 item per division/category/group/class.
6. Each item must be accompanied by a written description that provides construction details (requires but not limited to, fiber preparation, fiber content, techniques used, and intended use)
7. Written descriptions shall not exceed a 3" x 5" card and must NOT contain identifying information, including but not limited to alpaca name, individual name or ranch information.
8. 1st-3rd place ribbons will be awarded in each category/group/class.
9. The Judge or Show Superintendent may change the category/class of an item at his/her discretion.
10. Classes may be combined if less than (4) entries per class are received.
11. There shall be no ties in scores.
12. Judges decisions are final.

### RULES: Hand-spun Skein

1. Entries must be submitted in the name of the spinner
  - ◆ A completed entry tag must be placed in a plain clear zipper type gallon size bag with the skein.
2. Skeins must have been completed during the last year.
3. Hand-spun skeins will be divided by group (Beginner Spinner, Intermediate Spinner, and Advance Spinner), category (Yarn spun form commercially prepared fiber, and yarn spun fiber hand prepared), and class (classic yarn, hand spindle, and novelty yarn)
4. Exhibitor may enter 2 skeins per group/category/class provided they are of different fiber preparations.
5. Skeins must be at least (50) yards in length, 1½ to 2 yards in circumference, neatly wound, "figure 8" tied in 4 places and placed in a plain zipper type gallon-sized plastic bag.
6. Each item must be accompanied by a written construction description that includes fiber preparation, fiber content, techniques, pattern designer, yarn used, etc. This construction description shall not exceed a 3" x 5" card and must not include identifying information.
7. No substitutions at the show!

### 8. Judging Criteria:

- ◆ Items will be judged anonymously with points given for visual appeal (luster/brightness, cleanliness, color, skein appearance), Handle, Craftsmanship, Cohesiveness (amount of twist & execution, appropriate number of plys, diameter of yarn, structurally durable), Consistent application technique (dyeing/blending, novelty technique, and plying technique), Construction Description (yarn suitable for intended use, and fiber preparation techniques).
  - 1st-3rd place ribbons will be awarded in each group/category/class. Show has the option to award 4th-6th place ribbons.
- ◆ Classes may be combined if less than (4) entries per class are received.
- ◆ The Judge may change the category/class of an item at his/her discretion.
- ◆ There shall be no ties in scores.
- ◆ Judges decisions are final.

### RULES: Mill-spun Skein

1. Mill-spun competition will be divided by categories (skeins entered by a Mill demonstrating their best work, and skeins entered by an individual Farm showing the quality of yarn from their fiber) and classes (finer yarns, light/medium yarns, bulky yarns, novelty yarns)
2. Entries must be submitted in the name of the Mill or Farm depending on Category.
3. Skein must have been completed during the last year.
4. Each exhibitor may enter 2 entries per category/class provided they are from different production runs and/or dye lots.
5. Skeins must be at least 100 yards in length 1½ to 2 yards in circumference, neatly wound, "figure 8" tied in 4 places and placed in a zipper type gallon-size clear plastic bag.
6. No substitutions at the show!
7. Identifying information or labels on items is prohibited.
8. Judging Criteria:
  - ◆ Items will be judged anonymously with points given for visual appeal (luster/brightness, cleanliness, color, skein appearance), Handle, Craftsmanship, Cohesiveness (amount of twist & execution, appropriate number of plys, uniformity, structural durability), and Consistent application technique (dyeing/blending, novelty technique, and plying technique)
  - ◆ 1st-3rd place ribbons will be awarded in each category/class. Show has the option to award 4th-6th place ribbons.
  - ◆ The Judge or Show Superintendent may change the category/class of an item at his/her discretion.
  - ◆ Classes may be combined if less than (4) entries per class are received.
  - ◆ There shall be no ties in scores.
  - ◆ Judges decisions are final.

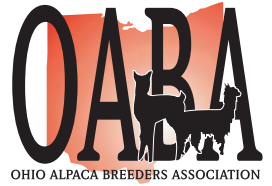

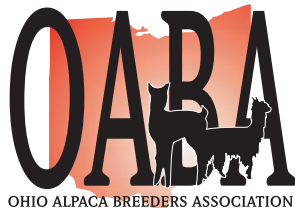
